We have been approached by a number of local agencies re the lack of free Community Care Law provision in the Bristol area.

As you know up until 2016 the Law Centre had a Community Care Team but unfortunately when the team left we had no choice but to cancel our legal aid contract.

As part of the new legal aid contracting round we have requested a new community care contract. However we need your help, it will take time for a new team to generate sufficient funds to cover their posts therefore we need to apply for grant funding.
